ORDINANCE NO. _______-2020

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE EPIDEMIOLOGY AND LABORATORY CAPACITY FOR INFECTIOUS DISEASES GRANT FUND

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Health Department has received an Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Infectious Diseases Grant from the Indiana State Department of Health for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the purpose of administering COVID-19 testing; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement of the said Grant program, a local, non-reverting, fund for the purpose of receipting, holding and expending allowable program receipts and expenses must be established; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to establish the "Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Infectious Diseases Grant Fund" for the above-stated purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Establishment: The Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Infectious Diseases Grant Fund (the "Fund"), which is assigned Fund Number 8901, is hereby established as a non-reverting fund to be administered and maintained by the Clark County Auditor.
- 2. Deposits into the Fund: Only monies from the said Grant program (and any matching grant funds, if applicable) shall be deposited into the Fund.
- 3. Purposes of Permitted Expenditures from the Fund: Money in the Fund shall be used only to pay those expenses allowed under the said grant program.
- **4. Term of Fund:** The term of existence of the Fund shall be perpetual until the Fund is fully expended or terminated by subsequent ordinance adopted by this Board.
- 5. Auditor's Duty to Manage the Fund: The Clark County Auditor is hereby directed

to maintain and manage accurate accounting information regarding the receipts, expenditures, and balances of the Fund as well as any reporting requirements pursuant to Indiana law.

6. **Effective Date:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of the Board.
