RESOLUTION NO. 2 -2013

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE  
2<sup>ND</sup> AMENDMENT TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION**

**WHEREAS**, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this “Board”), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-2-2-2; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-2-9; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Board trusts in the Constitution of the United States of America; and,

**WHEREAS**, millions of men and women have fought to protect the Constitution, including scores of Clark County citizens; and,

**WHEREAS**, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to the United States Constitution (“2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment”) states, “[a] well regulated militia, being necessary to the security of a free state, the right of the people to keep and bear arms, *shall not* be infringed” (*emphasis added*).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Clark County Commissioners supports the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment and a person’s right to keep and bear arms.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.


