

Clark County Drainage Board Administration and Implementation Policy, 2023-1

Whereas, under Clark County Ordinance 2010-11 (the "Ordinance") the Clark County Drainage Board (the "Board") is responsible for the administration, implementation and enforcement of the provisions of the Ordinance; and

Whereas, as part of the Ordinance, the Board must approve drainage plans where the development of land, with certain exceptions, disturbs 1 or more acres of land ("Drainage Plans"); and

Whereas, the Clark County Engineer, on behalf of the Board reviews Drainage Plans for compliance with the Ordinance and makes comments or reports to the Board as to whether the Drainage Plan is in accordance with the standards of the Ordinance; and

Whereas, the Drainage Plan is part of development plan (the "Development Plan") which must be approved by the Clark County Plan Commission.

The Board hereby adopts the following policies regarding the Board's approval of a Drainage Plan:


1. In keeping with the procedures of the Clark County Plan Commission regarding the approval of a Development Plan, the Board's approval of a Drainage Plan shall be valid for two (2) years from the date of the Board's approval.
2. If construction related to the Drainage Plan is not commenced within two (2) years of approval by the Board, the approval shall be void.
3. Any minor amendment to a Drainage Plan may, if it meets the standards set forth in the Ordinance, be administratively approved by the Clark County Engineer, and there shall be no additional fee due from the developer for such administrative approval.
