ORDINANCE NO. 17-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16-2017
CONCERNING EMPLOYEE PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously adopted Ordinance No. 16-2017, which said ordinance requires that the County shall deduct the employee portion of the monthly health insurance premium equally per pay period throughout the year instead of deducting the entire portion of the monthly health insurance premium in a single paycheck.

WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend said ordinance to require that in addition to the monthly health insurance premiums, all other monthly employee deductions, including, but not limited, to monthly premiums for vision plans, dental plans, supplemental plans, and any other such plans, shall be deducted equally per pay period throughout the year instead of deducting the entire portion of the said monthly premium in a single paycheck.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That in addition to the monthly health insurance premiums, all other monthly employee deductions, including but not limited to, monthly premiums for vision plans, dental plans, supplemental plans, and any other such plans, shall be deducted equally per pay period throughout the year instead of deducting the entire portion of the said monthly premium in a single paycheck.
2. That all other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 16-2017 shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.




