ORDINANCE NO. 08 -2024

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NON-REVERTING FUND ORDINANCE FOR
THE CLARK COUNTY PLAN COMMISSION**

(AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 17-2019)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the “Board”), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously adopted Ordinance No. 14-2007, which said Ordinance, among other actions, established a non-reverting fund wherein a portion of various fees collected by the Planning and Zoning Office could be deposited into the said non-reverting fund, up to \$150,000 annually, to be utilized by the Planning and Zoning Office in the performance of its required duties. Any collected fees in excess of \$150,000 were then required to be deposited into the County General Fund.

WHEREAS, the Board previously adopted Ordinance No. 17-2019, which said Ordinance amended Ordinance No. 14-2007 by allowing a portion of the various collected fees to be deposited into the said non-reverting fund in amount up to \$225,000 annually. Any collected fees in excess of \$225,000 were then required to be deposited into the County General Fund.

WHEREAS, at the request of the Planning and Zoning Office to further assist that Office in the performance of its required duties, the Board now desires to amend Ordinances No. 17-2019 to allow the various fees collected by the Planning and Zoning Office to be deposited into the said non-reverting fund without a limit or cap and without the requirement to deposit a portion of the various collected fees into the County General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Ordinance No. 17-2019 is hereby amended to allow the various fees collected by the Planning and Zoning Office to be deposited into the Clark County Plan Commission Non-Reverting Fund without a limit or cap and without the requirement to deposit a portion of the various collected fees into the County General Fund.

2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
