

ORDINANCE NO. 6 – 2008

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING LOCAL NON-REVERTING
FUND FOR SUPPORTING THE CLARK COUNTY SEVERE WEATHER
WARNING SYSTEM.**

(Short title: “Severe Weather Warning System Fund”)

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners (“Board”) is the county executive under I.C. 36-2-2-2 and, I.C. 36-1-2-9 the Board the Legislative body of the county authorized to enact Ordinances for the creation of local funds;

WHEREAS, the Board is empowered to establish non-reverting local funds for various governmental purposes from time to time,

WHEREAS, a need exists to establish a local non-reverting fund for the purposes of receipting, holding, and managing donations and other funding provided to Clark County for the purpose of maintaining the Clark County Severe Weather Warning System.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:


1. That each and every recital above is incorporated into this Ordinance. This ordinance creates the “Local Non-Reverting “Severe Weather Warning System” Fund”;
2. That this Fund be established as a local non-reverting fund to receive, hold and manage any donations and other funding which may be distributed to Clark County, Indiana from time to time;
3. That the Auditor of Clark County Shall keep records and monitor the activities of all receipts into this fund. Disbursements may be made from this fund without the necessity of appropriation by the Fiscal Body, upon a valid claim being presented to the County Executive and subject to other requirements of processing and publications as required by law;

4. That all monies remaining in this fund at the end of every budget year shall not revert to any other source; rather, monies shall continue to be held in this non-reverting fund, from year to year;


