#### **ENTRY FORM**

#### PERFORMING ARTS CONTEST

#### BASIS OF JUDGING ENTERTAINMENT ACTS:

- A) Entertainment Value = 50 points
  - 1) Is the act representative of good taste in entertainment?
  - 2) Does it show good craftsmanship in structure? Is it built around a theme? Does it work up to a climax?
  - 3) Is it conducive to the development of good talent?
  - 4) Does the audience enjoy the act? Is sustained interest shown?
- B) Skill and Quality of Performance = 40 points
  - 1) Does the act run smoothly without slip-ups, dead spots and delays in picking up cues?
  - 2) Do the performers project their voices sufficiently and articulate clearly?
  - 3) Are the performers true to character? Do they have animation? Do they use good showmanship?
  - 4) Do the performers use good technique in gesturing, sitting, standing, moving and keeping the stage balanced?
- C) Costumes and Stage Setting = 10 points
  - 1) Are the costumes and stage settings appropriate?
  - 2) Do they add to the effectiveness of the act?
